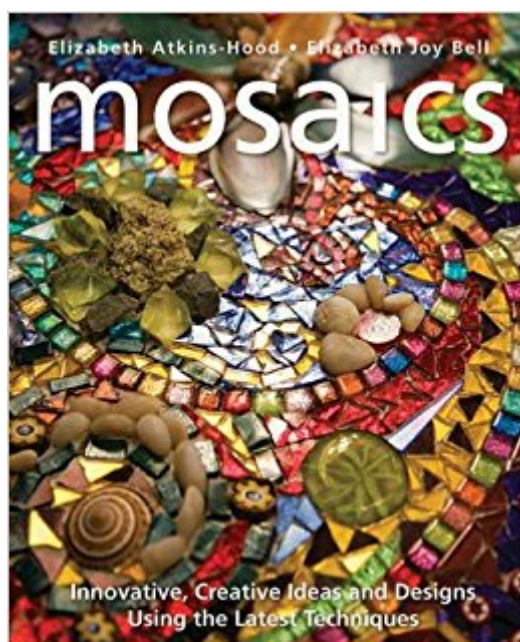

These two artists from New Zealand raise mosaic art to a brand new level! I love their free spirited, eccentric--sometimes totally crazy--and innovative projects, and their total immersion in the art. Their projects are not for the faint of heart, nor for the beginner, that's for sure, and you would need a lot--a LOT--of space to create pieces remotely similar, but their unusual techniques and approaches are a fantastic source of inspiration and ideas. The book includes lots of excellent

pictures and explanations. A wonderful and FUN book for those who are constantly looking for out-of-the-beaten-path creativity.

Anyone wanting to step outside the box with their mosaics should buy this book. I wouldn't suggest it as a first book for beginners, but for those who want to utilize more exotic and unusual techniques and decorative materials in their work.
