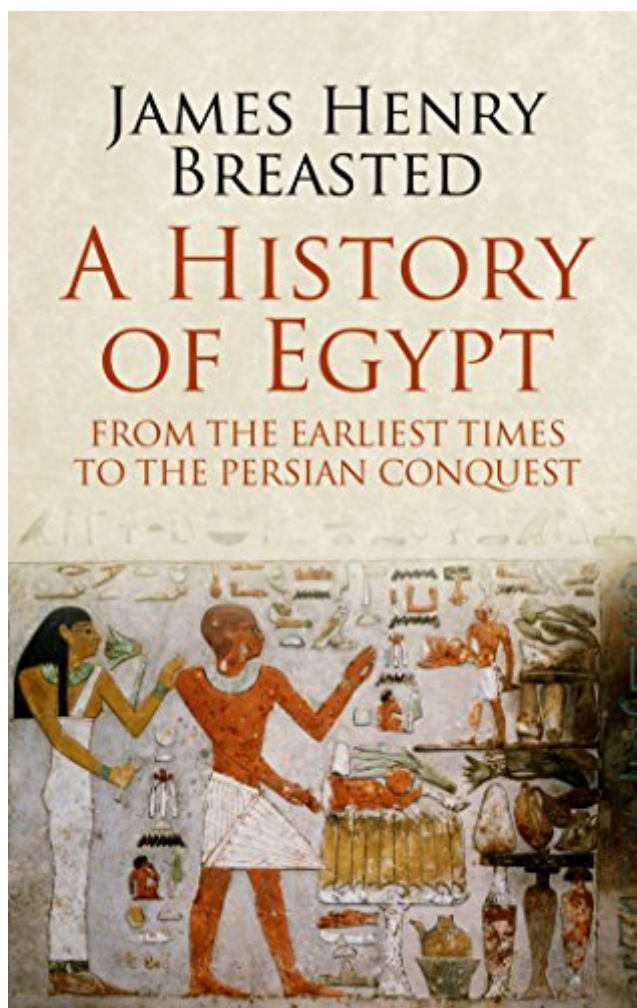


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A History Of Egypt From The Earliest Times To The Persian Conquest

Breasted breathes life into Ancient Egypt, forging a continuity of narrative that reveals much more than I expected to learn about the subject. His insights into the personalities of the pharaohs and their foes makes them sparkle through the intervening millennia! Dated language, perhaps, but very scholarly.

This is a reprint of a classic book that is very well written and a pleasure to read. Being originally published in 1905 it is unfortunately outdated in some historical detail, e.g. the timeline of the Thuthmoses. In electronic form it is also an excellent buy - I got it for less than 2\$. There are some typos, which seem to be the result of the OCR without careful editing, but these did not bother me. I can recommend the book to newbies to Egyptian antiquities like me, but one should rely more on the general narrative than on every historical detail due to the age of the book. If in doubt I have consulted Wikipedia for a second opinion, but where I had no doubts I may have been misled. However, rarely have I taken so much pleasure in reading an historical monography.

This volume is richly supported by references to existing records on monuments. Many more records have been lost because they were written on animal hides or other perishable materials. It would be helpful for the reader to have a map indicating the names of current geographical sites as well as the names of the ancient ones to enable one to visualize the areas involved in conquest and trade.

Both vols 1 & 2 of this long out-of-print classic belong on the reference shelves of any aspiring Egyptologist or ANE historian. And if the reader is truly serious, the companion Ancient Records of Egypt, vols 1-5 belong there as well. Breasted refers to these coyly as a 'dictionary'. They represent a completely new translation (ab ovo) of all memorials, et al extant at the time of the original publication - 1909 - and are referred to throughout the main history. This history, though dated, is a much better read than the more recent and stuffy work by Grimal (a sure cure for insomnia). Breasted is able to switch from a wonderful flow of descriptive narrative when giving a synopsis of The Land to a more scholarly mode without dropping a beat. Don't buy this book for the illustrations - being an off-print, they've suffered in the process but there are better places to find these anyway. The Oriental Institute Archives come to mind. This is the seminal work on AE history despite its age - the historical vade mecum for the AE buff.

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
