

And she builds her stapleless whereas GG' s book is staples and the New bible has been updated as stapleless techniques. She really knows her stuff. She has inspired me to build my own canoe. In this book she uses photos to help show you how to put things together. The only area I am unsure about is fiber glassing the hull. The products involved are expensive and they are rather complicated to apply. But since she did it and had success I figure I can too. Just follow the instructions for the chemicals you will be using. Even if you mess up you can always paint it. Ha Ha!

The downside to this book is that it doesn't cover lofting really at all, so you'll need another book for that (Buehler and Schade have some excellent guides to that aspect). This, however, has a really nice, illustrated, comprehensive description of what it looks like to build a strip canoe. It covers material and tool choices in more and better detail than most other books, and, aside from working up the plans, provides an excellent understanding of the design and construction of wooden

canoes. I have several boatbuilding books, but this is one of only two that I keep in my shop.

This book will give you the confidence to tackle your first stripwood boat project, guaranteed. Susan takes you methodically through each and every step of the process of building a stripwood canoe. She presents alternate methodologies of construction and woodworking that are tempered by knowledge and experience. I have two references at my side while building my Whitehall Pulling Boat - this book and Susan's latest work on building stripwood row boats. Other than the plans for my boat and the occasional advice of experts at The Newfound Woodworks where I got my plans, these books are all you need.
