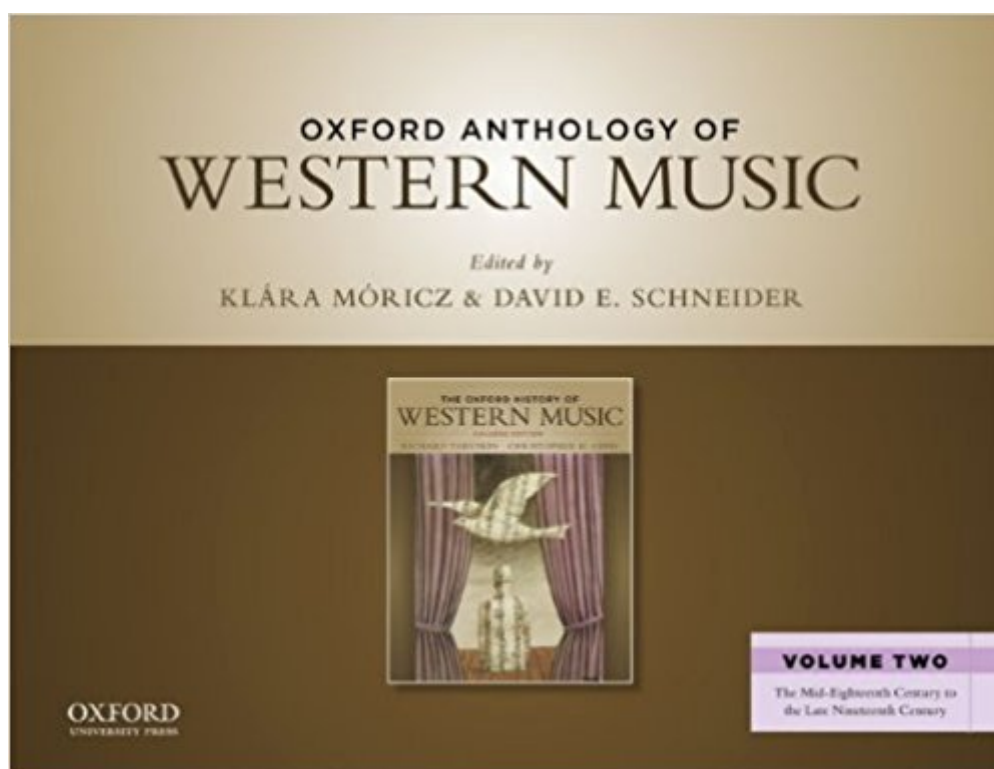


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Oxford Anthology Of Western Music: The Mid-Eighteenth Century To The Late Nineteenth Century

In all seriousness, The text was an asset in my class. It has scores for sections of many major works, and it's great for making my own arrangements of them. I like to arrange for classical guitar, but most of the pieces aren't written for it. This is a nice thick book of scores I would have spent more on had I bought them individually. Every piece has a written analysis and a little about the composer, piece, and/or time in which it was written. It gives historical context to every piece, making them more than some notes that a dead white guy slapped down on some lined paper. TL;DR: Great resource, looks fancy on a bookshelf.
