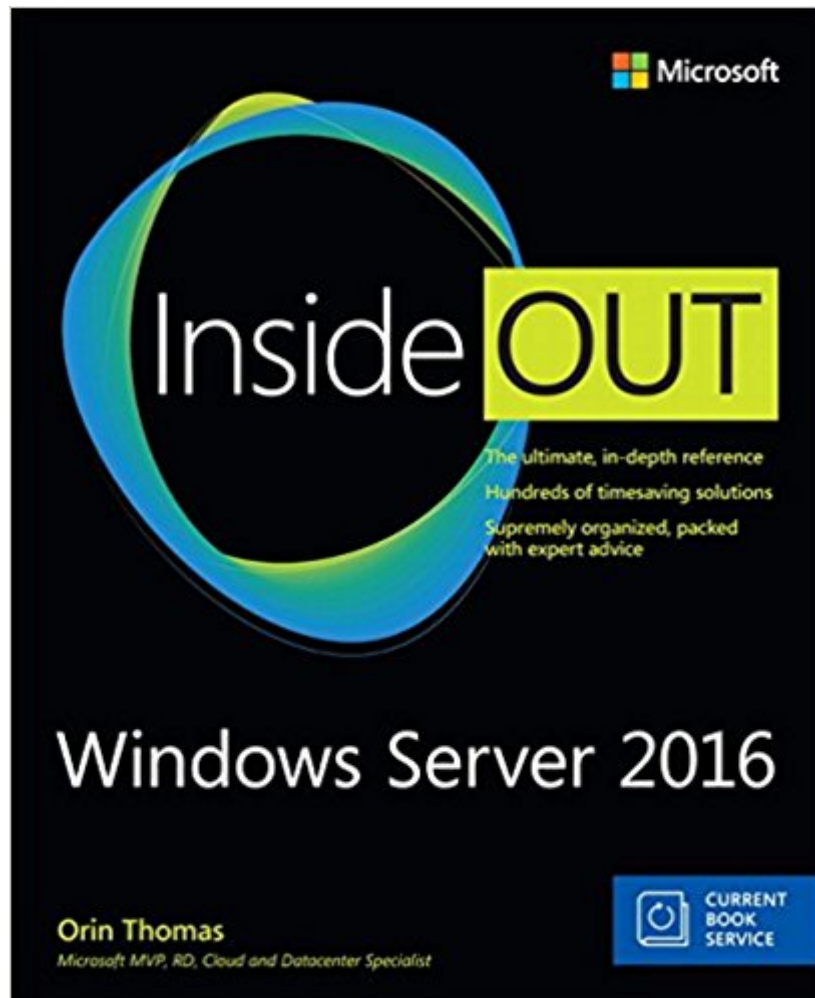

I like how it is written as at an Systems Admin level, building on what you already know about Windows Server. It is well designed to give you the realistic approach to implementing Windows Server 2016 in your environment. Whether it be on premise or in the cloud, there are plenty of examples on how to take advantage of the new features, using the GUI or Powershell. Also, this book has the Current Book Service, that keeps you up to date with any updates that are made to the book.

This is yet another thoroughly researched and thoughtfully produced text in Orin Thomas' corpus. This is an excellent, no nonsense, information source for Server 2016. As a general guide to quickly pick up changes and additions across the board I found this a very effective book. I found also it is very efficient for quickly referencing specific items (for example RDP) and being able to gain detail on new features with some relevant references to older versions without providing too much weight to the older information. I have been in the industry for 20 years and have a cumulative Windows knowledge from Windows NT 4.0 through each version since. This book will be great for anyone like me who wants to refresh and add to existing know how.

I've been fortunate to attend Microsoft Ignite (formerly TechEd) conference sessions and five-day

courses with the author over the years. There was always context to the content, where it was not just the "how-to" but the reasons "why" come from experience and speaking to attendees and clients over the years. There is only so much that you can search for online but, as they say, you only search for what you know. Blog entries tend to be first-out-the-door and rarely gets revisited for later edits, with even official documentation can be a bit scant on details. Windows Server 2016 needs to be seen more than just extending your supported security life cycle to solutions that can meet the quickly-evolving demands of today. This reference is full of "light bulb" moments for the seasoned administrator and IT professional in the Microsoft space, of what Windows Server 2016 can provide as a solution. I see a number of organisations who still set it up as if it were Windows Server 2003, or running a full GUI OS for both their hypervisor and virtual machine just to run a few applications. With the "Current Book Service", it will be great to have a reference and updates to features as they evolve. For example, Nano Server, now a container base OS image as of Build 1709, would be one of the changes to the book surely. The content has already changed my approach in advising others as an instructor and IT professional on the benefits of getting THE most out of Windows Server 2016, and I highly recommend it to them as much as I will to you.
