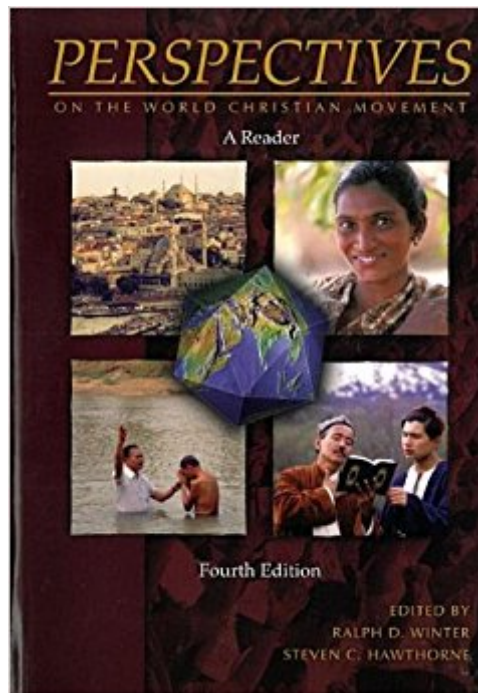

I bought this book for a class. Even though it says fourth edition, it does not contain all the same chapters as the proper 4th edition. I was very disappointed to figure this out at the very end of the course. If you are purchasing a digital edition of this book for class, buy the other one with the study guide included. It has all the proper chapters where this version is missing two.

Perspectives is a great resource for anyone looking for information on missions, both local and foreign. It's a big thick book that is comprised of short little articles written by people that have first hand experience. It isn't written in such a way as to compel the reader to forgo sleep because of being totally engrossed yet one will be quite challenged to look at various aspects of reaching people with the Gospel. This should be in everyone's library.

For every thinking Christian whether considering cross-cultural work or not, this should be required reading in addition to the course offered every semester in hundreds of locations in the English-speaking world. It has four parts: the Biblical perspective, the historical perspective, the

cultural perspective, and the strategic perspective. It will change one's world view!

With a Masters in Intercultural Ministries, I say without hesitation this book offers a profound and challenging message every person should engage. Better yet, read the book while taking one of the thousands of Perspectives.org classes available around the world. The Perspectives class brings in seasoned missionaries and teachers adding depth and application to the reading. Great book, which speaks about another great book and its story, the Bible.

This book has everything to train people to be on mission here in the United States. Different than the missional community movement, but drawing on some of the same thinkers and writers. People movements are the most powerful way to bring whole communities into obedience to Jesus Christ. It's only weak point is organization, but I went through the book and put in sticky tabs on the articles I plan to use to help my people perceive who is ready to hear the gospel and sense that God is sending them to reach them for Jesus. If you want to start your own missional community and bypass shortcomings with the missional community movement here in the United States, get this book!!
