

John Himmelman is the author and illustrator of more than seventy-five books for children, including Tales of Bunjitsu Bunny. He is also the author of Chickens to the Rescue, Duck to the Rescue, Katie Loves the Kittens, and Katie and the Puppy Next Door. As a martial arts student and instructor, he has a lot of experience with the human version of bunjitsu. He lives in Connecticut with his artist wife, Betsy.

Zen lessons for martial arts and life. These are just like those little polished wisdom stories from the far east. Except they're for children -- sweet, cute, and interesting to a child's mind. The lessons teach patience, resilience, action instead of just daydreaming, accommodating a friend, that you can sometimes forestall conflict with affection, that you should never let your enemy choose how you fight, and that sometimes you learn more after you've failed. But the stories are just fun, interesting little stories. My six year old and eight year old love them passionately, and the four year old likes them. After you read one of these stories, it doesn't feel like you've eaten your vegetables -- it feels like you've just had dessert, and dessert was unexpectedly good for you. We can't wait for another helping.
