Cade's quest to rid Wales of Demons continues in this exciting installment of the Last Pendragon Saga. Song of the Pendragon was a thoroughly enjoyable adventure/quest and I was totally engrossed right till the end. What I love about this series is the combination of paganism and

Christianity that infuses this story as Wales stands on the cusp of religious change - it is authentic to the period as Christianity begins to take precedence over the older religions. Cade represents both viewpoints co-existing together in a harmonious way - Cade is both Christian, yet he is also sidhe and great power has been granted to by the three-headed goddess, Arianrhod. In this installment Cade, together with his friends, make a deadly trip into the heart of Arawn's domain to face him and force him back into the under-world. Song of the Pendragon also satisfied my love of the romantic - Cade and Rhiannon finally acknowledging and accepting their love for each other (sigh).
