

This book is very short - I should have noticed that before purchasing it, so that's on me. Be aware, it clocks in at only 120 pages and in addition to writing, those pages also contain rudimentary symbols and black&white pictures; not to mention, there is a "notes" blank page after most chapters. These blank pages are included in the total pages, even though they contain no information. And, the font is larger than most books ... all, no doubt, to reach that 120 page total.

My issue though, and the reason for the 2 star rating, is due to the fact that this book is very light on content. There's nothing here that an average Google search won't produce. There are other "basic" and "beginner" and "starter" books on Paganism that are much better and more thorough. I strongly suggest you continue your search and by-pass this book.
