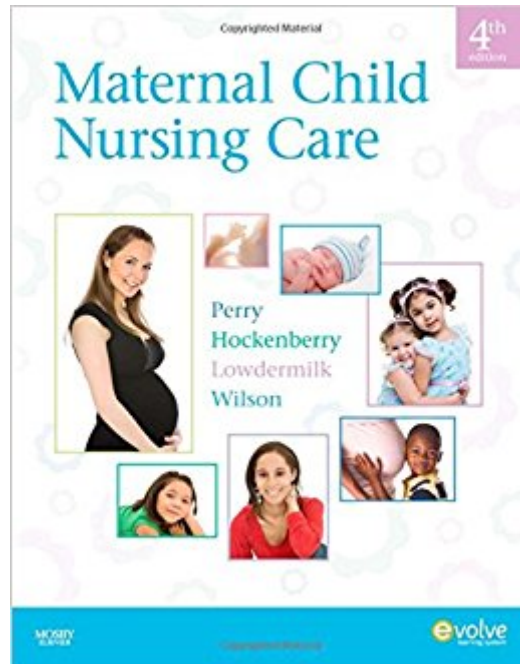




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# Maternal Child Nursing Care, 4e

This book is not useful for students. No bolded terms, no glossary, no review questions at the end of the chapters. My class also found two instances where the book completely contradicted itself on the same page. The main text said one thing, but the box above it would say the complete opposite. We actually had test questions thrown out because of it. It is almost like one author wrote the main text and someone else wrote the boxes, but they never communicated about what they were writing. This book has lots of good info of course, but it is not organized to truly help a nursing student learn. I went out and bought my own Peds and OB books for studying because this text was so bad. If it wasn't for those I would never have pulled an A and an A- in these subjects. Horrible book!

I found this book to be full of errors and full of fluff. The important information is so condensed that you could overlook it. The other information is redundant--almost as if the authors had to fluff up the book to meet nursing school standards of hauling around 3 inch books. There aren't any NCLEX style questions in this textbook. The study guide (purchased separately) is a joke--too many errors in the answer keys and the questions are a joke. I highly recommend picking another book by another author if you are allowed.
