

Grade 7 Up-This partial history of some of the most famous architectural monuments in Jerusalem includes the various incarnations of the Jewish Temple, the Dome of the Rock, and many churches. The period discussed is from Herod's Jerusalem (37 B.C.E.) to the present, with brief asides about older constructions, such as the first temple (Solomon's) and Hezekiah's Tunnel. The Knesset and Holocaust Museum (Yad Vashem) are covered, as is the expansion of the city since the state of Israel was established. The author explains why the holy sites are venerated by Jews, Christians, and Muslims, and discusses the resulting controversy and violence through the ages. The black-and-white photographs and reproductions add little of interest. The excellent bibliography includes periodical articles. Purchase as needed for architectural history collections.
