

The student atlas gives a very brief overview of each of the continents- if you are looking for info on a specific country this isn't the atlas to use. It does have interesting and various styles maps, though.

I love the fact that individual, beautiful, colorful maps of countries and continents, are on one single page, making map copying for my students easier to master. However, there are some features left off of these maps that can be found in other atlases, such as the Rand McNally, I use both, the Nat Geo for copying and scale, and the Rand McNally for features I am unable to locate.
