

Despite some excellent game action in the later chapters, this latest episode in the Football Genius series continues to focus on side themes—particularly the hazards of high living, loose talk, and shady deals going down in the world of pro sports. Here "genius" Troy finds himself at a middle/high school and overcomes both personal and political obstacles to turn its dying

football program around. Coaching and practice sessions get nearly as much play as the eventual gridiron heroics, and Green adds a particularly colorful young wide receiver to the cast.
