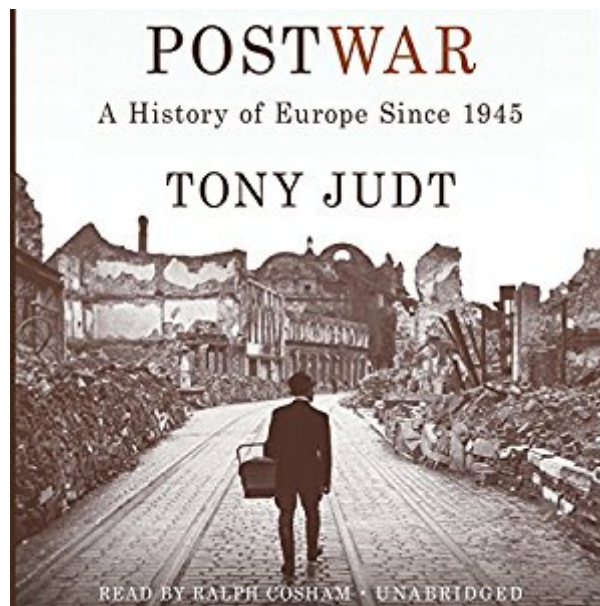

I have read more or less half of the book. I am learning a lot reading it, the author faced a very difficult task trying to summarize a lot of history and information into one book and I think he did it very well. The only bad comment that I could point out is the fact that the author skip some information about the most outstanding facts of history. For example Berlin blockade and Schuman declaration (two topics I found particularly interesting) deserve no more than 1-2 pages. The book is very well written and the style is very direct.

Tony Judt rules! The book may be a bit too detailed at times, but gives an extraordinary account of how Europe looked like after WW II, and how we came to the Europe of national states.
