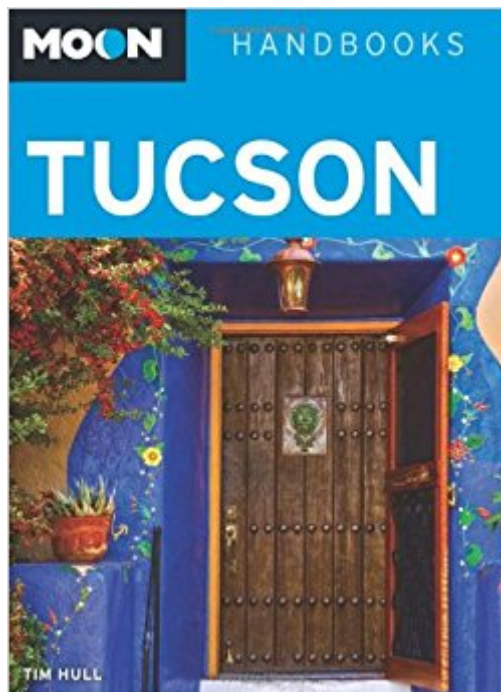

He covers legal issues for Courthouse News Service and has written for Tucson Weekly, High Country News, and other publications. His fiction has appeared in Santa Monica Review, Blue Mesa Review, and other arts journals. Tim is also the author of Moon Arizona.

I'm always suspicious about raves in guidebooks, especially for restaurants - taste is so subjective and often the most raved-about places are also the most expensive or hippest, which is not what I'm seeking on a family trip.
