

At first I could totally understand how Brianna was in love with Gil, but I got annoyed with both of them at different points. I got especially annoyed with Gil a few times. But it's a HEA and a good overall read. It got dragged out a bit much in my opinion but was a good light read nonetheless.

Loved the characters in this story. I could see a true father trying to make the best match for his girls ignoring the obvious that you can't force feelings. You can't force love. Faith filled knowing our Heavenly Father wants what is truly blessed for us.

The book started out great. However, I was very disappointed with the ending. It was obviously that the author did not have first hand experience with Catholic preparation for the priesthood. How the author fixed the problem of a seminarian falling in love and leaving the seminary left much to be desired! In fact both romances were just neatly tied up so the book could come to an end.
