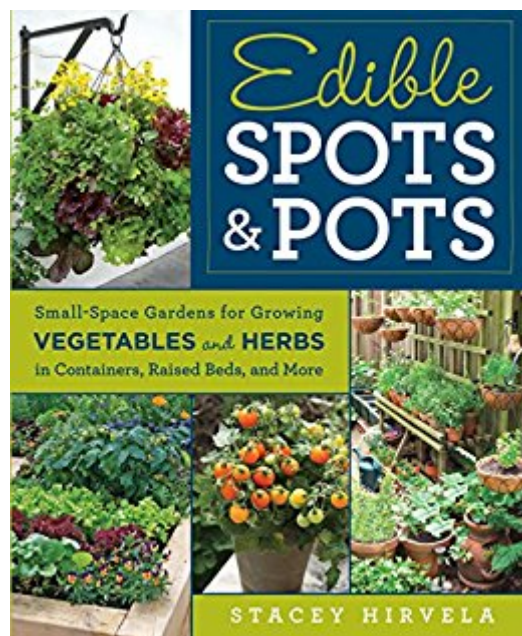

Author Stacey Hirvela shares many other interesting concepts, like One-Minute Veggies (foods that go from patio to plate in less than a minute) Doubly Delicious Crops that give two flavors from one plant, and space/yield ratios (vegetables worth their footprint). Gardeners will also find an enticing array of 60 edibles that grow well in a defined space for productivity and beauty.

This book has some great do-it-yourself projects, many of which do not require carpentry skills! And I really appreciated reading her honest opinions and experiences with some of the latest fads (such as the "upside down" hanging tomato pots). She uses a "thriller, filler, spiller" formula for making outstanding potted arrangements, which I found made it simpler to get good looking results than other books' suggestions. I would have liked more specific recommendations for herbs and veggies suitable to this approach, though.
