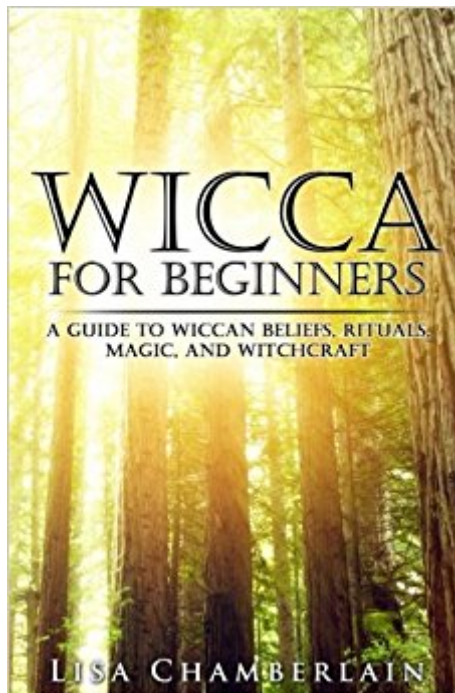




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Wicca For Beginners: A Guide To Wiccan Beliefs, Rituals, Magic, And Witchcraft

This book provides a good overview of Wiccan spirituality. It is a brief overview but extremely well-written. Took me about 2.5 days to read and there wasn't a single chapter that I didn't come away with something learned. In addition to the overview (which included discussion of the various traditions of Wicca) there are some example rituals you can use and she encourages you to modify them as suits you. As many people have said - the author is not pushy in the least.

I'm just getting interested in pursuing Wiccan practices in my own eclectic way. This book is a very quick and easy read, just a small taste of the history, beliefs, and Craft. If you're looking for a way to dip your toe into the practice, this is a nice start. However, it is certainly just a minute fraction of the tip of the iceberg, and you will absolutely need to read other titles if you intend to pursue this faith and its practices further, even from a beginner's standpoint. Still worth the read.
