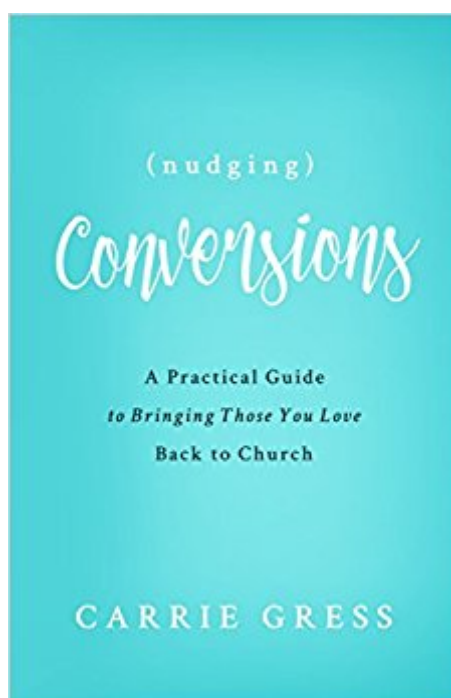


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# Nudging Conversions: A Practical Guide To Bringing Those You Love Back To The Church

This is a helpful, practical guide to advancing the work of evangelism in a subtle, winsome, mostly unobtrusive or completely unobtrusive (prayer) sort of way. Conversion is God's work and that is noted here. Prayers for the conversion of others are sort of automatic in the Christian who truly loves and cares for others. There is wisdom expressed here that includes guiding relationships and conversations to a deeper level. Overall, this is a short but worthwhile book but rewards the careful reader with thoughtful, accurate analysis and insights on evangelism, conversion, prayer, Scripture, culture, conversation, relationships, more.
