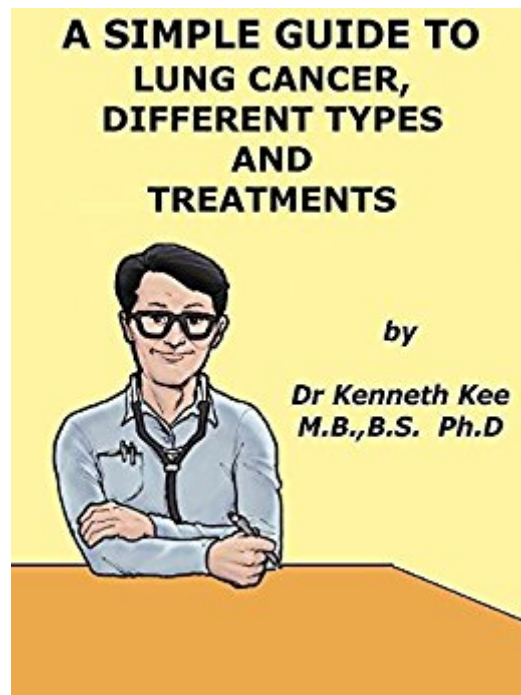

A Healthy Lifestyle
1. Take a well Balanced Diet
2. As usual the treatment of cancer consists of Surgery, Radiotherapy and chemotherapy. The choice of treatment depends on the size, extent and the type of lung cancer and the general health of the patient. Small cell lung cancer is mostly treated with chemotherapy. Surgery is not usually suitable because this type of cancer has normally spread at the time of diagnosis. Non small cell lung cancer can be treated with surgery, chemotherapy, radiotherapy or a combination of these.
Surgery
Part or whole of the lung can be removed in the treatment of lung cancer. After surgery the patient may require assisted ventilation for a short period. Physical activity may be limited for a while. If the remaining lung is in good condition, the patient may be able to live a normal life.
Chemotherapy: Certain type of lung cancer is sensitive to chemotherapy. It is used in combination with surgery and radiotherapy.
Radiotherapy: Radiation may be used in conjunction with surgery or to relieve pressure symptoms or pain caused by the lung cancer.
Targeted Therapy
Targeted therapy is a treatment that targets the cancer's specific genes, proteins, or the tissue environment that contributes to cancer growth and survival. This type of treatment blocks the growth and spread of cancer cells while limiting damage to healthy cells.
3. Keep bones and body strong
Bone marrow produces our blood
Eat foods rich in calcium like yogurt, cheese, milk and dark green vegetables.
Eat foods rich in Vitamin D, like eggs, fatty fish, cereal, and fortified milk.
Eat food rich in Vitamins B and C such as green vegetables and fruits
Zinc and other minerals are important to the body
4. Get enough rest and Sleep
Avoid stress and tension
5. Exercise and stay active.
It is best to do weight-bearing exercise such as walking, jogging, stair climbing, dancing, or lifting weights for 2-3 hours a week. One way to do this is to be active 30 minutes a day at least 5 days a week. Begin slowly especially if a person has not been active.
6. Do not drink more than 2 alcohol drinks a day for a man or 1 alcohol drink a day for a woman. Alcohol can affect the neurons and brain cells.
7. Stop or do not begin smoking. It also
