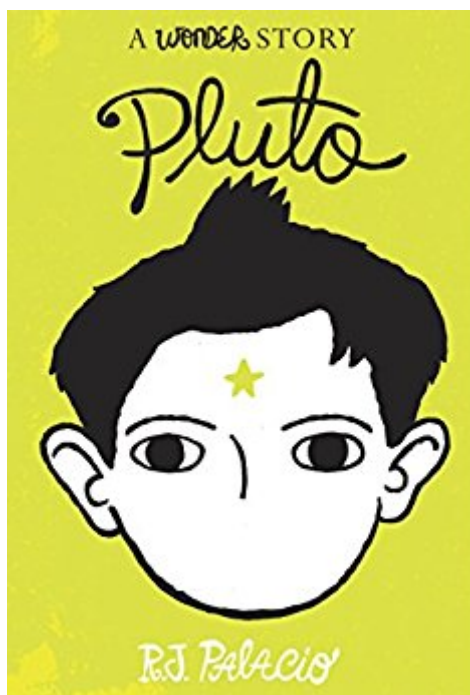

It follows the story of Auggie Pullman from the viewpoint of his long term friend Chris. Chris is a much smaller figure in the main story. It is an honest and realistic portrayal of the relationship between two boys, one marred physically by a birth defect and one "normal."

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
