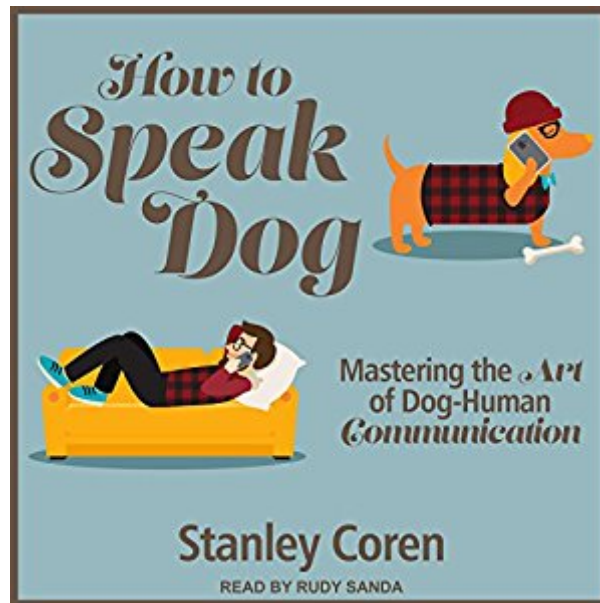

It's a very in-depth guide to the mind of a dog from a very well-spoken, intelligent and rather funny author. Some parts of the book can get a bit dry but almost every sentence is packed with pertinent and important information. I had a really hard time putting this one down and for a guide to dogs, that says a lot. Stanley Coren keeps it interesting with anecdotes and personal experiences, as well as mixing in a fair amount of humor. If you want to get to know and understand your dog better, or just dogs in general, then I highly recommend you order the book or buy this for Kindle! It is especially helpful for people who work around dogs, like delivery persons, or shelter volunteers, who can benefit from being able to read a dog's body language and understand the meaning behind its barks, growls and whines.
