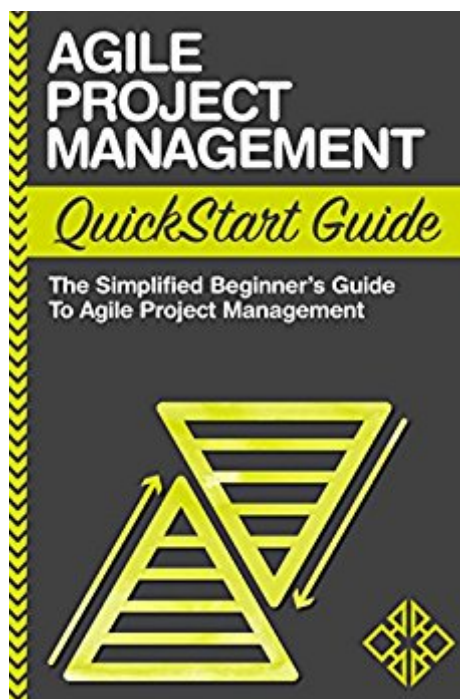

The book breaks down the history of Agile and then goes into providing the essential building blocks of what makes up Agile Project Management. I think it was well organized and would be an ideal tool for anyone looking to start working in an Agile environment.

This is a thoroughly researched book and it hits on all of the key concepts, but the writing is clunky at times and really only helpful to someone who has zero prior knowledge of Agile concepts. I guess it lives up to its "simplified beginners guide" subtitle, but I guess I was hoping for something a little more instructional and less expository.

I like this book because it examines Agile in detail, including its history, its inner techniques, and its implications for those who use it. The book starts with an outline of the importance of project management per se, works through the various aspects of Agile before turning to a discussion of two cases studies of its application in practice, and finishes with criticism that has been directed at the methodology. There is also an overview of the Agile sub-industry that has arisen, in terms of both advisory services and the software tools that its use necessitates.
